On November 4, Minnesotans will be asked to vote on the Amendment for Clean Water, Wildlife, Cultural Heritage, and Natural Areas. This




amendment would dedicate state funding, raised via a 3/8ths percent sales tax, to the support of Minnesota's natural resources and arts and culture.
